Dress For Success

Lesson attire has been sliding! Shirts need to be tucked in & hair put up. Instructors can't see your position in baggy shirts. Breeches or riding tights should be worn as jeans are destructive to saddles. Show riders should lesson in their tall boots. Jewelry can also be very hazardous. Please do not wear items that dangle or can get snagged.

Cellphone Use

As a safety issue, please do not use cellphones when handling or leading horses, riding, or even grazing. Both hands need to be free & your attention focused on the animal.

More About Boots...

Turnout boots belong in the bags on doors. Only fly sheet, cotton & nylon sheets should hang on the doors. Keep separate horse boots for riding in your trunk. (Boarders/leasers should have less worn boots for lessons, shows.)
